

## Guide to determine correct replacement lamp for Stand-Alone Units

## AC Version vs. DC version Style

- In 2010, the stand-alone machines were converted from a 120V AC to a 12V DC machine.
- Some of the AC version machines in 2010 were built with lamps that have the new bracket (DC Style).
- The actual lamp part for both versions are the same except for the bracket that holds the lamp.

## Original Style (AC Version)

- Machines purchase in 2009 or before.
- Some 120V AC machines in 2010 were built with original style lamp.
- The 120V AC machines have a thick heavy power cord similar to one that one would find on a toaster.
- In the original style, the white connector that is plugged into the lamp is imbedded in a metal bracket (see picture).

## New Style (DC Version)

- 12V DC machines purchase in 2011 or earlier.
- Some 120V AC machines in 2010 were built with the new style lamp.
- The 12V DC machines have an AC/DC transformer that plugs in the back of the machine which is similar to the old cell phone chargers from the 90s.
- In the new style, it is possible to unplug the white connector from the lamp since the connector is not imbedded in a metal bracket and is free hanging (see pic).
